Dear Parents and Carers,

This evening, WA Premier Mark McGowan announced a 4-day Lockdown that will take place from 12am (midnight) tonight until 12.01am Saturday July 3. Below is an outline of the arrangements and restrictions that apply to Orana Catholic Primary School.

- **Our school and OSHC will remain open.**
- **Parents may choose to keep their children at home, as with the previous lockdowns. Please follow Absentee Procedures.**
- **Parents are not permitted into classrooms or buildings.**
- **We encourage parents to use the drop off and pick up systems that are available. Staff will be on hand to assist.**
- **There will be no parent help.**
- **Uniform second-hand sales scheduled for tomorrow will be rescheduled for next term.**
- **Year 4 Excursion to SciTech will be postponed and rescheduled next term.**
- **Year 1 Excursion to the Zoo will be postponed and rescheduled next term.**
- **Orana Day Mass / Mini Fair and Volleyball event will be postponed and rescheduled next term.**
- **Graduation Fundraising Lunch will be postponed and rescheduled next term.**
- **There will be no extra-curricular programs this week including calisthenics, karate and sporting team training.**
- **One to one therapy will be cancelled and rescheduled.**
- **We will wait for further communication from CEWA and the WA Government and will keep you informed.**
- **The office will be closed. Please call on 9376 8300 from outside the office if you need to collect your children during the school day.**
- **If you enter the school grounds, masks must be worn and adhere to the 2m physical distancing rule.**
- **If you or your child is unwell and has symptoms, please stay at home, consult with your doctor and get Covid tested.**
