➤ On behalf of the Board, I present you with the Treasurer's Report for 2021.



Budget 2022


Our budget for the year ending 31 December 2021 approved by the Advisory Council for submission to the Catholic Education Office reflects a small balanced cash surplus based on the following assumptions:

- ➤ Student numbers throughout the year to average 465, including 60 in Kindy
- Tuition Fee Income to be increased by 2%
- ➤ Maintenance of Overhead Costs within a tight range of 2021 levels
- ➤ Government funding of Catholic Schools to continue in 2022
- ➤ A continued positive return from OSHC (after fee increases in July 2021)




