Dear Parents and Carers

As you are aware, Orana Catholic Primary School has received advice that a member of our community has tested positive for COVID-19 and was in attendance in Year 6 from 14th February to 17th February, 2022.

While the school and community is yet to receive detailed close contact advice from the Department of Health, we have acted with an abundance of caution. Parents and carers of students in Year 6, have been asked to keep children in at home, until you receive further advice from WA Health. Our school will work closely with WA Health and assist you with the information you require to identify close contacts, using the definitions for school and childcare settings.

We are well-prepared for Educational Continuity (remote learning) and we have comprehensive plans in place. We will provide further details regarding Educational Continuity via Seesaw.

Year 6 classrooms have received a professional Deep Clean on Friday, 18th February.

This development may make your child feel worried or anxious, as it will many of us who are parents. It is important to remember that you can help your child at this time; first by listening attentively to their concerns, then by providing some reassurance.
