Dear Parents and Carers,

I am writing to advise you there has been a positive case of COVID-19 associated with Orana Out of School Hours (OSHC). The individual attended OSHC on Wednesday (9th March) morning and Thursday (10th March) morning and afternoon sessions. The individual wore a mask whilst at OSHC and followed all health and hygiene protocols.

It has been determined that there are no school-based close contacts of this case. No students or staff are required to quarantine at this time and should attend OSHC and school.

Nonetheless, this news should come as a timely reminder for all members of the community to monitor COVID-19 symptoms and seek testing if symptoms develop.

Advice for all families and staff:

- OSHC and the school remains open.
- We ask that you monitor your child/yourself for symptoms of COVID-19 and get tested and isolate until you receive a negative result if symptoms develop.
- If you or your child develop symptoms, please do not attend school.
- Please note that the Omicron strain can present with less typical symptoms such as headaches and diarrhoea, particularly in children.

Our school continues to work in partnership with WA Health as we respond to the pandemic.
